Launch of Rodeo's New Pachislot Machine "Virtua Fighter"



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Fields Corporation (Head office: Shibuya-ku, Tokyo; President and COO: Takashi Oya) announces the nationwide release of the new pachislot machine from the Rodeo Co., Ltd., "Virtua Fighter."

The Virtua Fighter pachislot machine adopts the contents of the popular SEGA CORPORATION arcade and home video game Virtua Fighter, introduced in 1993 as the world's first 3D polygonal fighting game. Subsequent Virtua Fighter installments have seen significant advances thanks to their incorporation of cutting-edge technology, such as advanced CG graphics processing, and innovative elements.

SEGA fully cooperated with Rodeo and an advanced 20-inch doughnut vision is utilized to provide detailed, realistic graphical renderings of the showdown between an assembled group of fighters in the ultimate, global fighting tournament. In addition to blazing battle scenes incorporating a variety of special techniques and a wealth of combat variations, players can enjoy fierce combat thanks to the "VFL (Virtua Fighter Loop)" system that unlocks the game's most powerful secrets.

The Virtua Fighter pachislot machine signals the start of a new legend, intended not only for pachislot enthusiasts but a wide range of video game fans.
